

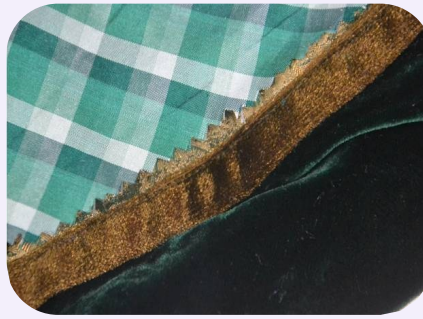
How To

Customise A Skirt

Equipment Needed

- * Skirt to customise
- * Korbond Tape Measure
- * Bias strip of fabric
- * Sewing Thread & Needle (Korbond do a pre-threaded kit)
- * Korbond Pinking Shears

“The owner of this skirt was going to a Burns night party and had nothing to wear and so she decided to add a tartan trim to cover the decorative band at the bottom of the skirt.”



Step One

Measure the depth of the band at the bottom of the skirt.

Step Two

Cut the bias strip of fabric to the same depth as the band of the skirt.



Step Three

Use a zig zag stitch to sew the top edge onto the skirt.

Step Four

Trim the lower edge using Pinking Shears. This not only looked pretty, it was much easier and quicker to fit than if sewing the band on both top and bottom edges.
