

# How To Make Flower Bunting

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## Equipment Needed

- \* Selection of old shirts in a variety of patterns & colours
- \* Craft Scissors
- \* Needle & Thread
- \* Craft Buttons
- \* 3m Ribbon

### Step One

To make the petals of the flower, draw a 12cm diameter circle onto your chosen fabric (draw around a cereal bowl to ensure all circles are the same size). Cut out 5 circles to make one flower. Repeat until you have 10 flowers in total.



### Step Two

One by one fold each petal in half and sew around the curved edge with a running stitch. Pull the stitches tight to gather the base together forming a petal shape and tie off any thread ends. Repeat with all the fabric circles until you 5 petals to each flower (10 flowers in total).



### Step Three

Sew 5 petals together to create a line. When you have all 5 sewn together, join the first petal to the fifth one to make a ring of petals. Gradually ease the flower together ensuring the centre is closed together. Ruffle the petals if needed.



### Step Four

Sew buttons in to the centre of each flower. Using a running stitch sew the flowers onto ribbon to create the bunting.
