

How To Sew on a Button



Equipment Needed

- * Needle
- * Thread to match the garment
- * Cocktail stick

Step One

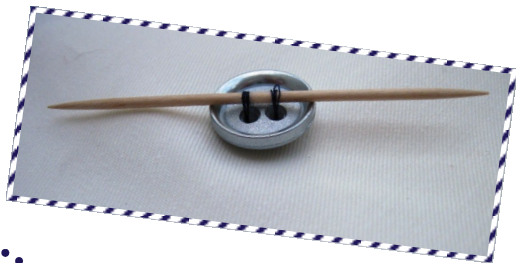
Start by using a double thread with a knot in the end and sew 2 backstitches on the wrong side of the garment.

Step Two

Bring the thread through to the right side.

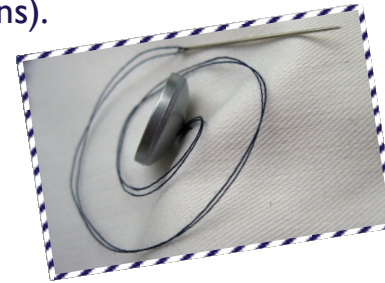
Step Three

Sew the button loosely to the garment by placing a cocktail stick between the button and the garment.



Step Four

Remove the cocktail stick and wrap the remaining thread twice around the thread between the button and the garment to form a shank (do this on flat and shank buttons).



Step Five

Finish off by pushing the needle through to the wrong side of the garment and securing it with 2 backstitches.
